How we deal with bullying:

At Alexander Hosea Primary, many parents have wondered what and how we deal with bullying. In this leaflet, we are going to inform you on how we deal with it.

Our anti-bullying strategies:

In the classroom is where we deal and teach children how to deal with bullying. We do may different activities to teach the children how to deal with bullying and what is right and what is wrong. We do activities that are fun but knowledgeable such as: role plays, posters, raps and songs, poems, Jigsaw activites, W.I.T.S and Wickwar Rocks.

Anti-bullying week:

One week during the school year, we have an anti-bullying week. On this week, all of the children have a chance to say and learn about bullying/ how to deal with it. At school to help the children learn how to deal with bullying we use W.I.T.S: W= walk away; I= ignore; T=talk to them and S=seek help. On anti-bullying week, there is a special assembly (done by Mrs. Windmill- reception teacher) to advise children how to break free from bullying and how not to be a bystander.

Pupil council charter:

The pupil council produces a new charter every year to inform children at Alexander Hosea Primary what bullying is. This helps children to know when someone is bullying them and when they are not. We also teach the children how to be safe from bullying.
