In the past fortnight we have:

- Been visited by Cordelia Cripps, who has been consulting with the digital leaders, staff and governors about developing the current ICT Suite into a more flexible space (possibly a STEM Lab) to suit the school ethos.

- Started our draft plans for the new projects (to launch in January) and carried out peer critique in a staff meeting.

Catering Working Party

The catering working party has been set up as a short term team to follow up on some comments that were brought to Parent Council. The team is made up of: 2 senior leaders; 2 representatives from Integra catering; a governor; 2 parents and 3 lunch break supervisors.

In our meeting today, we started to review the parent questionnaires (on survey monkey) and the comments from children at Pupil Council. We found that several aspects could be addressed through raising awareness about the service (e.g share how sourcing and use of organic foods, along with 75% home cooked meals contribute to the overall 'healthiness' of the menu on offer). Integra are preparing a FAQ for parents to respond to some of the questions that arose.

There are two different views with the calendar. The most helpful view we find is the 'month' one as you can see events clearly, without having the click on each one.




