English: Write a poem or prayer with the theme of Harvest/Autumn. This should be handwritten in your best writing and can be any style of poem. You could record your information as a table, chart or with photographs and notes.	Geography: Choose a different country anywhere in the world. Find out about what type of government they have (e.g democracy), who rules the country, how many people live there, what products do they export. Choose how you present your information.
Maths: Design and make a game to help learn your times tables and related division facts. You need to include instructions on how to play your game.	Art: Paint or draw a natural object.
