Maths

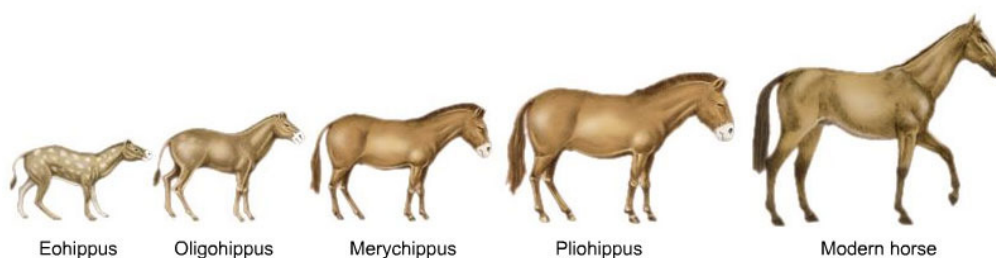
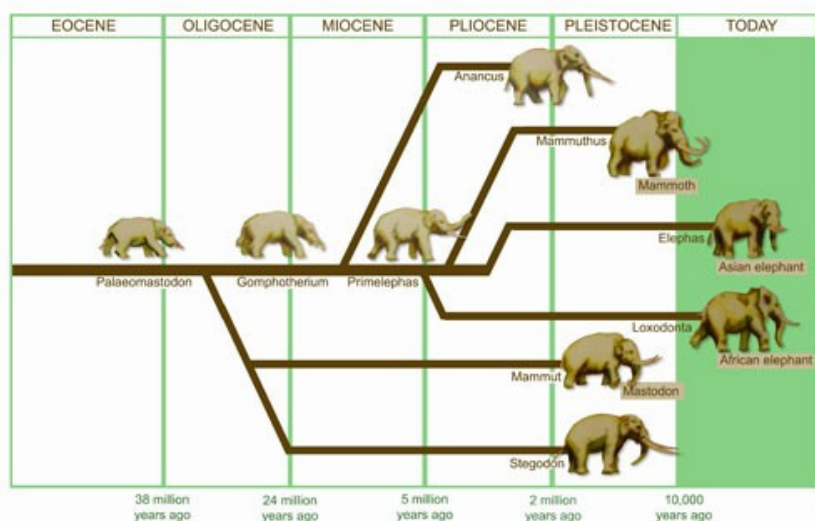
Revision of topics that the children have identified as weak areas: We have focused on solving multi-step word problems, long division and Venn diagrams.
