Survive or Thrive?

Science Week -Materials Investigations

The children have carried out various different investigations this week and have worked well as a team and used good scientific and problem solving skills.

Problem 1: How can we separate a sand and salt mixture?

This took a bit of thinking and I gave the children a bit of time to find the solution themselves; all groups eventually realised they would need to use different techniques for the two solids. We have had salt water evaporating in dishes and sand drying out on paper towels all over the classroom.

Problem 2: How can we clean some very dirty muddy water?

This required a series of sieving and filtering techniques and the children had to work out which equipment to use and the best method. The end result was that most groups finished with very clean water.
