Our learning this week....

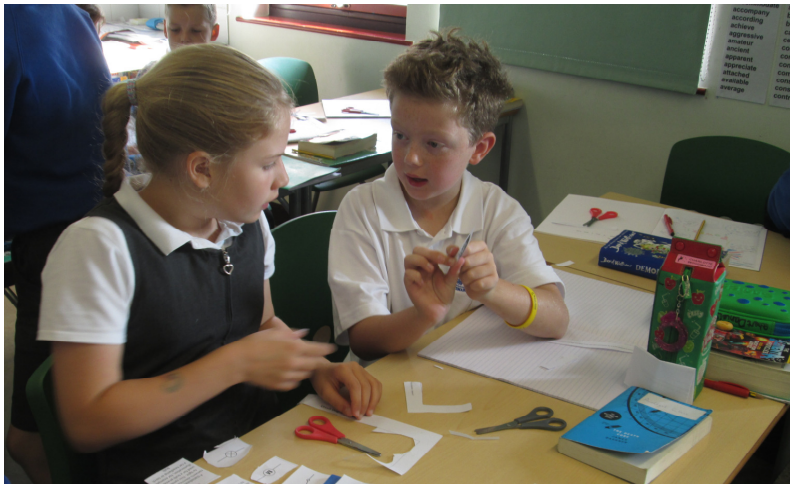
Theme- We have written an email to our local MP inviting him into school-the children were excited to get a reply and hear that he is keen to come into school in a few weeks!
