What we have been learning:

English: We have continued to develop our 'PEEing' (Point, Evidence, Explain) skills within reading comprehension, applying these skills to the inferencing of characters.

Maths: We have been reviewing the importance of estimation. The children have learnt that it is important to estimate before carrying out a calculation so they can compare both answers. The children then applied their addition and subraction skills to problem-solving. They were able to use trial and error to find as many possible outcomes as they could.

This has now inspired them to create a presentation where they will try and convince the rest of the class to vote for their charity to support.
