The reflection on being a purple learner is in acknowledgement to the learning zones we have displayed in the classroom. The idea being that you are working on an appropriate level of challenge (purple maybe sometimes red) and not in your blue comfort zone. I'm sure if you ask your child about this they, will be able to explain it even further.
