On Monday ,the children visited The Lifebus and explored the theme of making the right choices and the importance of being able to say no when faced with peer pressure . During the session the children took part in discussing dilemmas and possible outcomes regarding alcohol and cigarettes in an age appropriate way with puppets and short videos. They learnt how important it was to be unique and celebrated the fact that we are all different.Back in class, we took part in role playing real life situations where the children needed to make safe choices.

Dr Tom Robson worked with us on Wednesday and encouraged the children to use "Gem Powers".

Diamond – taking responsibility and solving problems

Emerald – standing on the edge and be able to be calm when faced with a challenge.

Opal – being kind, doing acts of random kindess and smiling at others. Sapphire – being able to ignore monster distractions.
