Our learning this week:

We have had a real focus on English skills and have been exploring spelling rules especially irregular past tense verbs and carrying out an investigation to discover how many different types of nouns there are. We have also focussed on the development of reading comprehension skills and the children have been practising how to find evidence and explain their answers using clues in the text. In maths we have been rounding numbers to 10.100 and 1,000 - we explored this kinaesthetically first on the playground using number lines.

Our sketches of ocean creatures are nearly finished and here are some of our creations.







In our project learning, we have been using our computing skills by working collaboratively to research which ocean creatures are endangered.
