What have we been learning?

This week in Emerald class, during PE, the children learnt the skills to strike a ball starting with different body parts, then striking with a bat.

The children timed each other in pairs and recorded their results in a table indicating how many seconds it took. Then we collected all the data to make a class graph to see who was the fastest.
