What have we been learning?

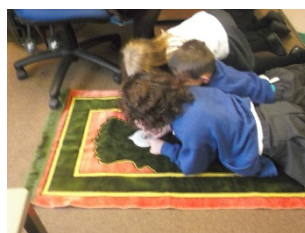
It's been another busy week here in Emerald class; the week kick started with the dodgeball event to raise money for the British Heart Foundation!
