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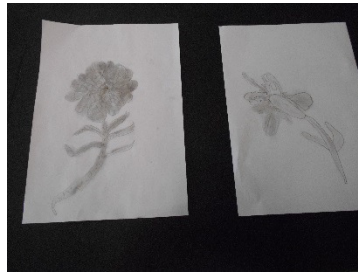

What have we been learning?

This week, we have had an art focus, and have been focusing on flowers. At the beginning of the week, we used pencils to sketch and make observational drawings of a flower of our choice. These are just 2 of our fabulous sketches, and there are more in the Key Stage 1 corridor!



At the end of the week we created our own version of Van Gogh's sunflowers, this was after we had been out into the garden to plant our own sunflower seeds- we wonder whose will grow the tallest.

In Maths, we have been looking at making estimations by rounding numbers up to their nearest 10, to estimate what the answer might be.

Next Term

In maths, we will be consolidating our knowledge of using $<$ $>$ $=$ whilst looking at the place value of numbers to 100.
