Where Will Exploring Take Us?

In Terms 5 and 6 we will be using the following texts: The Giant Arctic Jellyfish by Chloe Savage, Hom by Jeanne Willis. We will also read Dougal's Deep Sea Diary by Simon Bertram, Grandad's Island by Benji Davies, Arctic Tale by Rebecca Baines, Little Polar Bear by Hans de Beer and Ice Trap by Meredith Hooper.

To immerse our learning environment in Terms 5 & 6, we will have an icy mountain backdrop, blue ceiling drapes, Shackleton's tent and starry fairy lights to create the night sky. A campfire will be set outside Shackleton's tent. To reflect the tropical and hot places that we will be exploring we will incorporate a rainforest inspired learning area. A tropical rainforest backdrop will frame the walls along with hanging vines. A tree trunk and green drapes will form a rainforest tree. A separate learning zone will reflect a tropical island with a tropical beach backdrop, golden drapes to represent sand and blue drapes to create waves. Cold Pressed Mandarin and Sea Breeze essential oils will be used to fragrance the classroom.
