



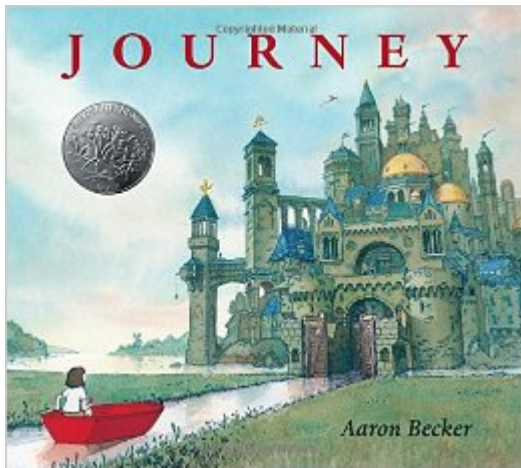
Pearl Class Newsletter
