We've been busy getting into our new project and have packed in lots of fantastic learning this week!

In **Maths** we have been using rulers to measure objects in centimetres. We have also learnt about mass and have been using balance scales to compare weight after making predictions. We have been using the language heavier and lighter to describe. In **English** we have been learning about plurals and when we need to add s or es to nouns. We have been writing rules for how Little Red can keep safe in the woods next time he visits Grandmas. To help us with this we enjoyed spending a bit of time in the school wood area, after we'd recalled the rules! The children were great at remembering the rules they learnt in their forest school sessions in Topaz.

In **History** we have started our learning about queens by looking at a simple timeline of some of the events of the life of Queen Elizabeth II. In **Art** we are learning about sculpture and have had our first exploration kneading and rolling clay. In **Computing** with Mrs Mac and Mrs Mason we have started learning about simple programming and have been using the beebots.
