This week we finished sharing the story of Tadpole's Promise. The children have loved this story and have a good understanding of the lifecycle of a tadpole. Some children have written alternative stories using their imagination; one tadpole has even been to visit the queen!

Our maths focus this week has been around measure and pattern. We found out that butterflies have a symmetrical pattern on their wings so we have been investigating patterns that are the same on both sides with lots of different things in the classroom.

We have been measuring our models, how far we can jump and how far different Easter eggs roll (not chocolate ones).



The children have been making plans to improve the outside learning area. They have some great ideas; flowers, large sand and water trays, a tree house. We talked about their brilliant ideas and looked at prices of items online. We decided that we need to raise some money. The children thought that if we make some stalls for Easter like a school fair, they might have enough money to buy some things. We plan to run a cake stall and a tombola during parents' evening times. We will need some help to run the stall. Please let us know if you can help when it isn't your appointment. I will put a sheet on the door for you to sign up for a time. You will find a recipe in the blue book that you could use to make something for the stall.
