Find out now if your family qualifies for free school meals.

Your child may be able to get free school meals if you receive any of the following:

- Universal Credit (with income of less than £7,400)
- Child Tax credit (income of no more than £16.190)
- Income Support, Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance or Incomerelated Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 The 'guaranteed element' of
- Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit.
