	 Lunchtimes Positive feedback on the new menu with more variety and larger portions. In one class, some children are feeling a bit rushed when they are the last class in to lunch. 	Mrs Windmill to look into

Portion sizes are improved from last year. Scopay is a better system and parents like to be able to book meals in advance.
