Please see emails sent out this week about chicken pox, scarlet fever and strep A.

Children with chicken pox should stay away from school for 5 days and until the spots are crusted over.

Children with scarlet fever should stay off for 24 hours after starting anti-biotics.

Children experiencing vomiting and/or diarrhoea must stay off school for 48 hours from the last episode.
