

## School Meals

Reminder-please ensure lunches are paid for **in advance** of any meals taken either online or by cash or cheque. The cost is **£2.10 per meal**. If you would like to pay online and do not have a unique reference, please contact the office. Topaz (Reception) will shortly be issued with a reference and instructions.

Parents will now be able to pay for all future school trips online as well as being able to keep track of lunches as we move towards a cashless school. Your help would be appreciated with this.

### Reminder about attendance and punctuality

Regular attendance is important for children to develop good routines for later life and ensures that they do not miss important development points in their learning.

It is also very important that the children arrive in class by 8:55am for registration so that they are able to have a smooth start to the day with the rest of the children in the class. It can be unsettling for children to arrive after the morning routines have started.

### Wizard of Oz Theatre Visit – 6<sup>th</sup> December 2017

### Tesco Bags for Schools

The project is "Pond area renovation"

The pond area has unfortunately become very overgrown and we are currently unable to use it. We would like to clear the area, re-line and re-fill the pond and add a bark pathway. If we raise enough money, we would also like to buy an information board and some bird hides. The idea being to create an outdoor learning area which all pupils could have access to.

We are delighted that our application to the Tesco Bags of Help Grant Scheme has been successful and our project will be put forward to a customer vote in the following Tesco stores:

To vote, you will need to make a purchase within store of any value. You will receive one token per transaction and it's not necessary to purchase a carrier bag in order to receive a token.

Voting will take place from **now until Tuesday 31st October** and we will be notified by the end of November 2017 to confirm the amount of funding we will receive. The project with the highest number of votes across our region will receive up to £4,000, the second placed project up to £2,000 and the third placed project £1,000. If we are first in the vote, we will receive the amount that we requested in our application.
