Providing Learning Mentors for targeted children to meet PSE needs and raise attainment, particularly in English and Mathematics.

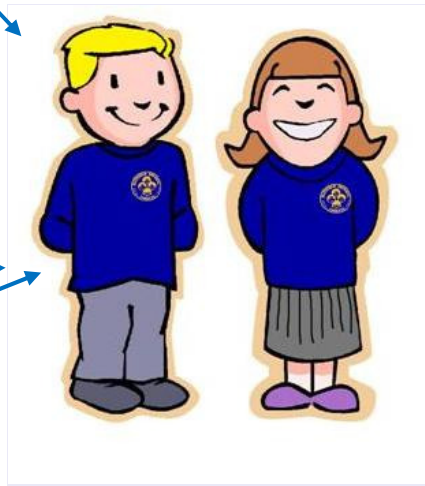

Developing a nurture space for children with sensory resources.



Other measures put in place to meet the needs of children eligible for Pupil Premium include:-

- Pupil Premium children identified in daily planning.

- Priority in pupil progress meetings/data analysis.
