#### Dear Parents/Carers

The teachers have completed their end of year assessments and are putting the finishing touches to reports, so that these can be sent home with your child on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> July. If you require a second copy of the report (eg for separated parents), please contact your child's teacher by Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> July. The report format has been slimmed down this year to support Teacher workload and make it more user-friendly for parents. In the English section, 'R' stands for Reading and 'W' stands for Writing. If there is a \* next to an outcome, this means they were very close to achieving the next standard.

We have been very proud of the children this year. They have emerged from the difficult covid time very successfully and shown adaptability, self-belief and perseverance. It is our privilege to see them grow and develop and play a small part in their lives. We have three more weeks left in school and our priority will be about supporting their transition to their next class. We are fortunate that all our teaching staff will still be with us in September, so they will continue to keep a caring eye on their current class as they move forward. We break up for the summer on Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> July.

## Transition

Our annual 'Shuffle Up' days will be on 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> July. During these mornings, the children will spend some time in their new classrooms with their new teachers as part of their transition.

The teachers are also in the process of passing information on to the next teacher. There will be 'Meet the Teacher' sessions in September for parents.

## Attendance

Consistently very good attendance helps children to access the full curriculum and receive the support and challenge needed to move their learning on. We are fortunate that the vast majority of our children attend school very well. We know that some children have missed school this year for holidays in term-time due to changes from 2020-21, as a result of covid cancellations. For the coming years, please try to book holiday during the 13 weeks of school holidays.

% attendance will be reported in school reports:

- 96%+ is expected and very good
- 95-95.9% is close to expectation
- 90-94.9% is cause for concern
- 89.9% or less is classed as persistent absentee.

Where attendance is becoming a concern, parents may be invited to School Attendance Meeting (with targets set for improvement) and fines may be incurred in the case of persistent absentees or prolonged unauthorised holidays (more than 5 days). Our S. Glos Education Welfare Officer supports us with attendance matters.
