#### Meeting

#### Feedback received from Topaz/Jet and Diamond

#### EYFS transition (follow on from last term)

- Parents asked whether school could review the phased transition into Reception for future years to help working parents.

Mrs Williams and Mrs Windmill to consider the phased entry schedule for Sept 24

#### **Uniform**

 Sample of new PE t-shirt provided. Will be moving to these (probably from Jan 25 – waiting for confirmation) - Children will be able to wear old and new tops during the transition period (until July 2025). Cost £11.25 each (so more than previous t-shirts, but should last longer) Mrs Williams to share in newsletter

#### Catering

- Could payments for toast pass on to new term (when child is off sick)? If off for a day, child could have addition slice the next day. If off for longer than this, parents can email the school address and request a refund (after the child returns to school).
- Brunch is back! As requested by Parent Council

#### **Lunchtime arrangements**

- We have more than the H&S ratios of staff since covid bubbles.
- Minimum expectation would be 5 lunch break supervisors per shift.
   We aim for 8 per day (plus 6 SEN TAs). We have a vacancy for a 5 day colleague and looking for more bank staff.
- Lunch staff follow a class/classes, so that there is supervision in hall and outside. They are accessible to the children and may sometimes stand centrally to be able to view whole space if the class is spread out over a wider area (so that they are visible for the children they are caring for).

#### Maths workshops

- P/C request for maths workshops to show the calculations and expectations for each year group, so that parents can better support at home.
- Link to calculation policy will be added to newsletter

#### Reading progression from phonics books to coloured bands

- Parent in Y2 interested in finding out more about when children come off the phonics scheme (usually in Y2) and how this progresses to free readers.
- KS2 parent asked how children are supported to choose an appropriate when they are a free reader (in Y3/4). KS2 parent noted that their child has appropriate books and help from teacher/TA to select.

Mrs Williams to ask Miss Clark -English Leader to provide clarity about this for Y2-4 parents.

#### Pens for KS2

- The Frixion pens are costing a lot of money per child. We are spending approx. £500 a year on ink refills alone for KS2. This is not sustainable.
- The children will be given new handwriting pens, when their Frixion pen inks run out. Parents can provide Frixion pens refills (black ink) if their child would like to continue to use these.

Mrs Price to let parents and children know about the change of pens.

#### **Non-school fliers**

- Parents appreciate these and either read or ignore as not school related.
- A couple of parents couldn't view in the format sent out recently (in the body of the email), so Mrs Packer will add as an attachment instead from now on.

#### **Parent Helpers**

- Parent requested more notice if needed (or not) to help on trips. It is hard for parents to get time off work at short notice.

#### **Communication about home learning**

- Teachers share the class homelearning in weekly class newsletters.
- Parents noted that some classes don't put the deadline for homework to be completed on it. They would like deadlines included every time, so that the timescale is clear.
- Noted that Mathletics is set regularly in most classes would like this set regularly in all Ks2 classes.

#### **Emails**

- We have moved from Teacher2Parents to Scopay in autumn term. This was communicated to parents at the time.
