From Mrs Williams.

We hope that everyone enjoyed a sunny, relaxing half term. What a lovely week it was! The children have been telling us about their adventures.

Year 5 are on their residential trip this weekend and happily more glorious weather is expected. We hope they have a wonderful time together. I know that Miss Edgar, Mrs Gee and Mrs McAleese are really looking forward to it too. I am very grateful to them for giving their weekend to take the Y5 children away, so that the children didn't miss out (after the original date was not possible). Have a great time everyone.

As you will be aware, we have some children and staff who are self-isolating after a positive case. I would like to thank the children, staff and parents for the smooth handling of collection of children on Wednesday and the move to remote learning. It was good to see some of the children at home join in with the Jigsaw assembly that afternoon. Events remind us that even though there are lots of reasons to be positive about the opening up of restrictions (and these are very welcome to us all), there remains the underlying risk of covid nationally and locally. Please remain vigilant around symptoms and sensible about social contacts.

I sent an email to parents on 9th June with helpful information about testing from South Glos Public Health team. It is important that primary age and younger children do not have lateral flow tests at home, but if you feel they have a **high temperature (37.5 or above); new and persistent cough and/or loss of taste and smell**, they must not come into school and parents **must book a PCR test**. NEW! It is possible for family members who have been in direct contact with a positive case to book asymptomatic testing through NHS website <https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test> or calling 119. PCR testing helps the NHS to gather information about the spread of variants (in particular the Delta variant at the moment), as well as picking up any cases where there are no or mild (eg cold/hayfever type) symptoms in those that have been exposed to a positive case.

Parking: polite reminder

Thank you for parking considerately around our school. A side benefit of staggered school starts and ends is that traffic around the school is less congested, which has been appreciated by our families and the neighbours. When parking, please remember to:

- Keep your eyes open for pedestrians, scooting children and cyclists;
- Drive slowly – no more than 20 mph;
- **Keep the 'drop off' bay clear of parked cars (this is for a quick drop off only and cars should not be left unattended);**
- Avoid parking on pavements, school zigzag markings and across neighbour's driveways;
- Only use the staff car park if you have prior agreement from the school due to parent or child mobility issues.
