We plan to send out the updated Helper in School handbook and post the presentation on Google Classroom by the end of next week.


All Helpers in School need to

Secondary School Admissions 2022

If your child is in year 6 and was born between 1 September 2010 and 31 August 2011 (inclusive), they must attend a secondary school in September 2022 unless you decide to educate your child at home. This is a very important decision and you are strongly advised to read the South Gloucestershire Secondary school admissions guide before making any decisions and completing your application. Applications for secondary school admission must be submitted by the 31 October 2021.

Applications for primary school admission must be submitted no later than **15 January 2022**.

As part of our preventative measures for covid, we are required to keep all spaces (including classrooms) well ventilated (windows open). We also open all doors when the class are at break to get a flow of new air through.
