Supersonic Citizenship Award

Each term the teachers choose a 'supersonic' citizen from each class. The children can earn this by consistently demonstrating excellent attitude to learning and behaviour. From these nominations, staff choose a child from the infants and child from the juniors to win the Citizenship Cup (silver trophy), which they can take home and keep for a term. The awards are highly regarded and children strive to achieve them.



Sporting Award

In October, we added a new award to our portfolio: the sports award. The award is for exceptional contribution to sports and PE in school.

Haydon Music Award

The Haydon Music Award is also awarded 6 times a year. Teachers nominate children who they think show passion and commitment to music. The glass trophy is awarded to one child a term.



Creativity Award

The creativity award is a metal statue of a painter at work on a canvas. This termly award is given to one child a term for demonstrating exceptional creativity in their learning across the curriculum (eg art, writing, creative thinking/problem-solving).

Party food


Your child's teacher will have let you know the party dates for their class.

Attendance

We have very good attendance at Alexander Hosea and we know that almost all children are punctual and attend school well.

It is very important for <u>all</u> children to be in school on time every day. This gives them the best opportunity to build strong routines; access the full curriculum offer (including focused pre-learning and interventions as needed) and have their social and emotional needs met.

Children are expected to arrive by 8:59am (the gate closes at 9am) and must be collected promptly at 3:30pm.

When attending clubs after school, children must be picked up on time too. Please check with the club provider if you are not sure of the end time.



WOOSC is governed by a group of volunteers, without whom we cannot run. To keep WOOSC open and running, we are seeking to replace two of our core roles on the committee; Chair, and Treasurer.

The role of the **Chair** is to provide support primarily to the Day Manager, the Business Manager, and Bookkeeper to enable them to undertake the day to day running of WOOSC.

Responsibilities include:

- Budget and spending approval
- Ofsted main contact point
- Supporting liaison with school, community centre, and other 3rd parties to ensure smooth running of WOOSC
- Approval of procedures and policies
- Support staff management including pay and performance reviews

The role of the **Treasurer** is to provide support primarily to the Bookkeeper to ensure club finances are being appropriately managed. Responsibilities include:

- Quarterly account review with Bookkeeper
- Annual finance report for AGM
- Signatory and access to WOOSC accounts
- Ad hoc review and audit of expenditure

For the Chair role, WOOSC would consider a role share between a Chair and Co-Chair.

If the roles are unable to be filled, WOOSC would unfortunately no longer be able to operate as these roles are core to the constitution, running, and governance of the club.
