Lock down procedure

At some point in the next term we will be practicing a lock down procedure. It is recommended by the local authority that it is good practice to have a plan of how to bring children into the building in case of an emergency in the close vicinity of the school.

This will be communicated to the children by the class teacher in a sensitive way, so that it does not cause unnecessary worry for the children.

Due to the nature of the procedure the details will not be shared with parents, but please be assured that the Governors and staff have followed advice about best practice.

Pick up arrangements at the end of school (Reception and Y1)
