## Attendance

We are really pleased with the overall attendance of the children. Your child's % attendance is at the bottom of the first page of the report. Good attendance is important as it builds positive routines, supports children's personal and social wellbeing and enables the children to access the full curriculum on offer at our school.

## Achievement: effort, progress and attainment

For each subject, grades are given for effort and attainment. In Maths and English, progress grades are also provided. All attainment grades are determined through teacher assessment of children's performance across the year. For children in Year 1, 2 and 6, parents will also receive a print out of statutory outcomes:

- Y1 phonics outcome (out of 40). The pass mark is 32;
- Y2/Y6 end of phase results (for Year 6 these include test results for reading and maths).

**Year 6**: In Year 6 statutory outcomes sheet, the teacher assessment outcomes for Reading, Maths and Science are either EXS (at expected standard) or WTS (working towards the standard). There is not an option to include GDS (greater depth standard), which many of the children will be. Please see the school report for more detail about teacher assessment for Reading and Maths.

On the reverse of the Year 6 sheet, you will find the scaled scores for Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling; Reading and Maths. Scaled scores of 100-109 show that the child has achieved the expected standard in the test, scaled scores of 110+ is greater depth. The maximum scaled score is 120.
