Dear Parents/Carers,

The final term of the year is well underway now and we are in the process of finalising our staff deployment plan for September. Except for Mrs Windmill, who is retiring in July, we are delighted that all of our teachers will be remaining on the team. We will let parents know where the teaching team will be allocated in the next newsletter. As our largest (double class) cohort will be leaving us at the end of Year 6, we will reduce to our normal size of 7 classes (one class per year group).

Assessment

All of our end of year assessments are being drawn together and finalised over the coming fortnight. These will be shared with parents in the end of year reports, which the teachers are busy beavering away on behind the scenes.

Transition

Our Wellbeing Team meets termly to discuss additional support (including ELSA) for the coming term. This term the focus is on transition support for children to may need it. These sessions have now started. Our value this term is resilience and we are focusing 'Be resilient' in assemblies and in classes. We also focus on 'Changing Me' from the Jigsaw programme in PHSE lessons. We talk a lot about change being part of life and learning from past experiences to help us to manage our next steps. We have also been learning breathing techniques to help us to stay calm. Y6 took part in a moving on session with Kooth and will be visiting their new secondary schools soon.

Academisation

As you will be aware, we are a local authority-maintained school with South Glos Council. Over recent years, many local schools have moved from this into an academy trust (eg Charfield to CSET). As more and more schools migrate to academies, the services provided by South Glos have been shrinking and many are no longer provided by the council (eg HR, health and safety, catering, GDPR etc). With this in mind, our Governors have set up a working party to consider our options in relation to academisation. For the past two years, we have been engaging in some aspects of the high-quality leadership professional development offer by a local multi-academy trust (MAT), called The LEAF Trust, which is based in South Glos. We also continue to engage with the South Glos Alliance school improvement offer for locally maintained schools. The Governors have not yet decided whether or not we might consider joining a MAT, but decided that it would be prudent to consider what may be best for the school in the years to come.
