
BACK TO SCHOOL

Amethyst A and Amethyst B will be outside at the same time so you can see each other but you have to stay in your bubble zone. There are markings across the playground and field splitting the area in half.




Your 2 metre home learning will help you imagine the distance!

Scientists have said that washing hands is one of the best ways to stop the spread of the virus, therefore we will be doing it regularly through out the day!




In at the goose gate


