## Newsletter




Amethyst have come back after half term full of energy and ready to learn all about WW2! In fact, they have come back teaching me lots about the war.

In maths this term, we are looking at fractions. Last week, we recapped equivalent fractions and how to find the simplest form. This week, we were looking at fraction arithmetic questions and how to answer them using our knowledge of equivalence.

Our book this term is Letters from the Lighthouse, which is about two siblings that are evacuated to Devon. So far, the children have written a letter home and a missing poster for the older sister, Sukie.

In science this term, we are looking at light. On Monday, the children were using torches and mirrors to investigate if they could manipulate light to make it “bend” by creating a mirror maze. They had lots of fun doing this – until it came to tidying up!

During PE this term we are doing netball for our game’s unit, and “Flight from Danger” for our dance unit. For netball, so far, we have practiced our throwing and catching skills. In dance, we have been working on moving to the beat of a sing.
