We have had a great start to the term in Amethyst class this week. The children have all really engaged and taken on the role of Year 6's well.

Our WOW Day focussed on a cocoa conundrum in which the children took on different roles. We started with farmers, then the chocolate factories, shops and customers.

During English this week, the children were recapping word classes and looking and non – chronological reports. Ready to write their own one in a couple of weeks.

PE this term will be hockey and dance. In hockey, the children have been practicing dribbling and niggling! Next week, they will be using these skills in a match!
