Project: Why do people leave their homes?

We have launched our new project with a WOW day where the children were evacuees for the day. They enjoyed being transported back to 1939 and spent time preparing for evacuation with constructing gas mask boxes, making identity cards and labels. There were several air raid sirens during the day and the children finally arrived in the countryside and were 'chosen' by their new host families!
