Life Bus/Life Skills and Anti-bullying week

This week we have had a PHSE/Science focus. We visited the Life Skills centre last Friday and had an exciting and memorable afternoon learning how to deal with potential hazardous situations and learnt valuable skills for Life.



On Monday we had a session in the Life Bus, which has been visiting the school this week. We were learning about the impact of drugs on the body and talking about choices we might make in the future.
