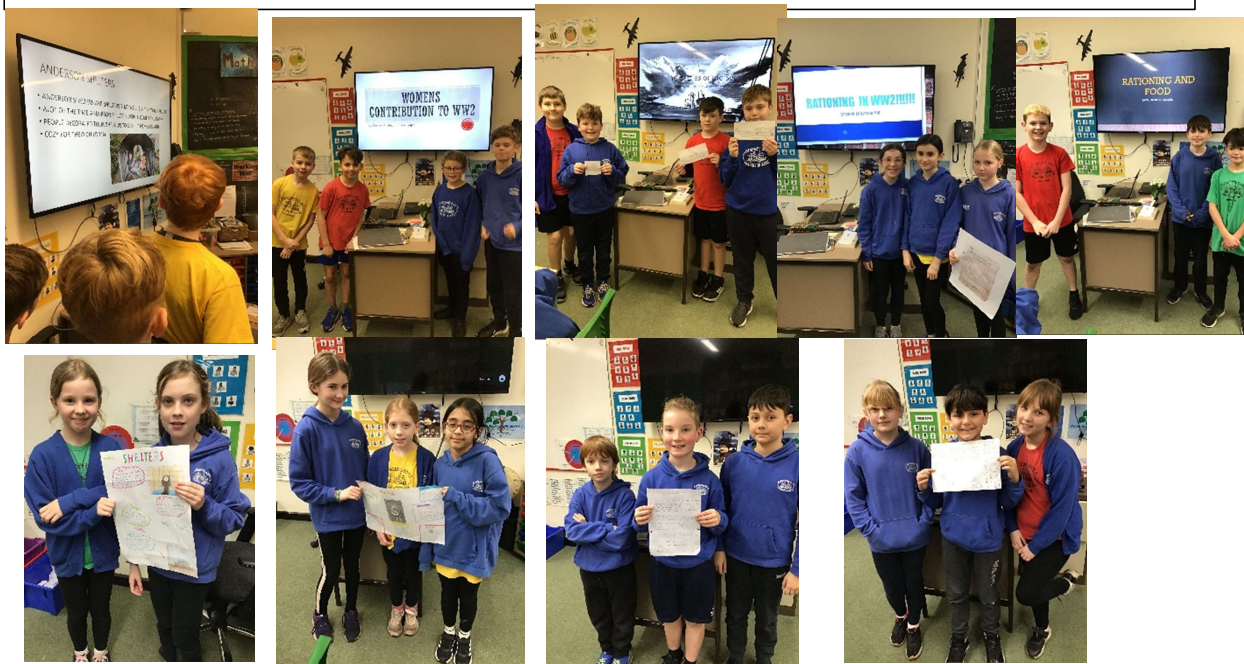


Amethyst Class Newsletter
