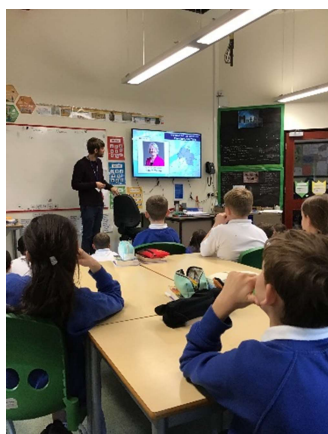


Maths – Calculation methods for dividing by 2 digits by using the method Long Division
