Music

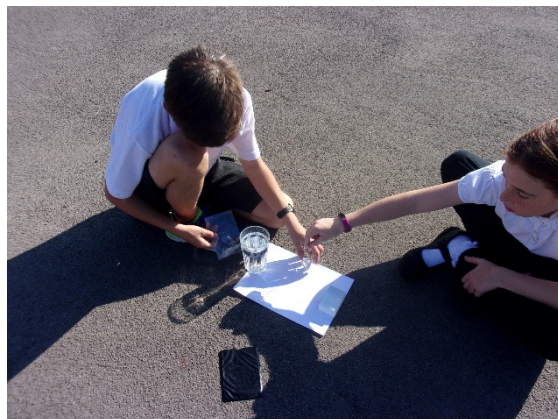
