This week we have been studying the tools used by authors to get across characterisation. The children have been writing a new chapter for our class book adding in a new character of their own invention.

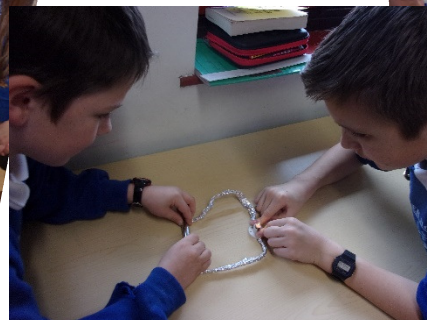
Science
