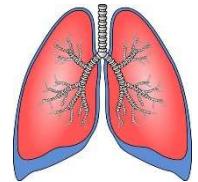
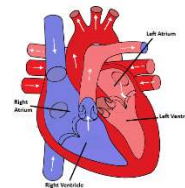
Our learning this week... How Can We Make Life Fair?

Maths

This week we have learnt how to use BIDMAS (BODMAS) to determine the order of operations when doing calculations. The Mathematics set for the next week will give a chance to practise this further.

Science
