MORFA BAY - TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

Monday 24 May -Children to arrive at school between 8.00 am and 8.15am through main school entrance and meet in school hall. Medicines (Must be in original packaging with Pharmacy label with child's name and dosage) should be handed personally to Mrs Gee before leaving. A maximum of £12.00 in £1.00 coins in a named purse to be handed to Mrs Brooks before leaving. Please ensure your child has his/her school hoody/school sweatshirt to travel in.

Coach pick up is 8.30am. It would be appreciated if parents do not park on the roundabout if waiting to wave the children off to allow plenty of room for the coach. There will be a short stop at a service station on the way when the children will have the opportunity to eat their snack. (Fruit/bottle of water). **Children must bring a packed lunch to be eaten on arrival to Morfa at 12.00am.**

Friday 28 May–Children vacate their rooms by 9.30am. After the morning session, the coach will arrive at 11.00 am for loading to leave centre at 11.30pm. A packed lunch will be provided by the centre to be eaten during the stop at the service station on the way home. Arrive back at school by 3.30pm. We usually text parents with a more specific time if running early and parents may meet their children from the coach and bring them home.

I will be preparing a PowerPoint which I will put on Google Classroom with more details regarding our stay. Please remember to complete and return the consent forms that were handed to the children on Wednesday as soon as possible. Full payment is required by **10 May 2021.**
