#### Curriculum



Cross Curricular theme- How Will We Evolve?

- English-Discrete and cross curricular.
   Expectations of writing, reading spelling and grammar are very high in new curriculum.
- Reading is a school focus. Children MUST read at home (please sign logs weekly) and do any spelling and grammar homework.

#### Curriculum.....



- Maths-New SATs consists of a 30 minute arithmetic paper with 36 questions it is vital therefore your child has very quick recall of all times tables up to 12 x 12
- TTRS and Mathletics set each week and is linked and updated with new curriculum material. Your child should use pencil and paper and can get help from help button or a family member!

### Additional Support

- Intervention for maths, reading and writing
- We will support children in class with the above but there may be times when children have 1:1 support or extra core teaching in small groups.

### Home Learning

- We have moved this to Google Classroom.
   There will be a home learning task set on Google classroom linked to the theme. These will be set every 3 weeks, which should give the children plenty of time to complete.
- Once finished the children should unload to the assignment section and I will feedback.

# Spelling

- Weekly spelling tests on a Friday.
- We are starting with year 5/6 word list and they will have 10 highlighted in their home school diary for each week.
- Test at home at the weekend and then test daily through the week.

## Reading

- Expectation ALL children will read at least 5 times a week and record in home school diary.
   A minimum of 50 pages a week.
- Logs should be signed by an adult and brought in for checking on a Friday.

- Spellings, tables and signed Reading Logs for Friday
