Keep listening despite any distractions

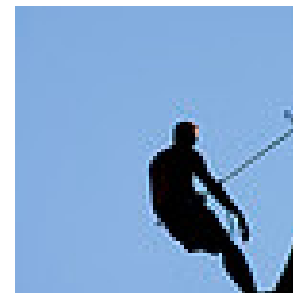
