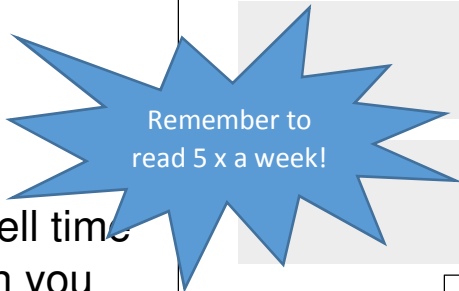




## Maths

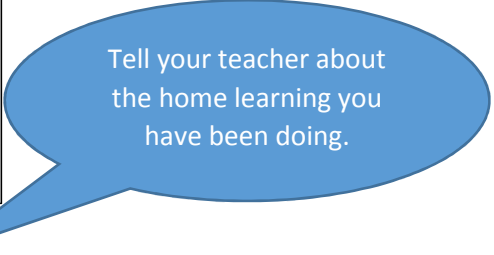
**The Arts**
