Happy Friday! Crystals have been finishing off their time topic in maths this week by reading timetables and figuring out durations of time. We have now finished our time lessons and will be moving onto measurement and conversion of measurements. Please keep time practice going over the end of year 3 and start of year 4 to allow the children to pick it back up again with ease in year 4!

In English, we have been writing an alternative narrative paragraph from Om's viewpoint. The children have done brilliant jobs at this and have become lovely little writers. Next week, we will be creating an advertisement to go and live in The Stone Age!

A reminder that children need to be reading 5x a week out loud to an adult. If they are reading in their heads all the time, children can find it tricky to then apply the same fluency when reading out loud. This is something we have started to notice in class. If your child is finding the book they are reading too hard, switch to I read, you read so that you can share this book together and get a smaller, more manageable book for them to read to you, if you need any assistance with choosing books that are more suitable to your child's reading place, please don't hesitate to ask me for help!
