## This Week:

This week, we have been getting to grips with our apostrophes. The children have been learning when apostrophes are appropriate in their writing and they have looked at the difference between possessive apostrophes and contraction apostrophes.

In Maths, we have also been problem-solving our division, looking at reasoning and true/false questions. Our maths has now seeped into our first project where we are looking at angles.



In order to start our programming, the children looked at angles in order to give turn instructions. We went on a right angle hunt which was greeted with great excitement. Within minutes, the children realised there were right angles everywhere! You may find that they will be hunting them out at home too.

We then progressed to recognising how many right angles are in a whole turn. We played a game which involved the children following right angle instructions, turning the correct amount of right angles in the right direction. This will lead to the children writing algorithms with right angle instructions.
