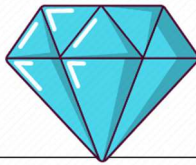


Crystal

In English, we have been reminding ourselves of how to write in 1st person ready for our narrative writing and planning next week. We will be writing The Stone Age boy but from Om's perspective.

The children also had their first drumming lesson and they really impressed the new music teacher with their listening and doing skills.

We will be starting time next week. Please ensure that you recap time over the weekend. Last year the children were doing quarter to, quarter past, o'clock and half past as well as 5-minute intervals. We focus on lots this year including to the minute, 24-hour time and digital time. They also need to be able to work out duration and recognise the time from roman numeral clocks. Getting your child an analogue watch is a great help when it comes to teaching time.

The minute hand being longer and the hour hand being bigger. Recap the o'clocks. (12 o'clock, 4 o'clock) Writing from a different perspective such as in 1 st person.
