They have practised using these sentences in their story writing and are building on these sentences by adding in adverbs and adjectives. We have also looked at spelling and using homophones in our writing and how to use them in the correct context. The children enjoyed using their imagination to create some very interesting sentences!

In maths we have continued to work on our mental maths skills. We have looked at threedigit numbers and how we add and subtract one-digit, two-digits and three-digits. The children have been encouraged to use their existing skills and knowledge in place value, number bonds and counting to support their mental maths development. Next week we are hoping to look at written calculations (column).
