We are very busy in Crystal class as we come up to the middle of the term! We are full steam ahead for Christmas preparing our play and our pictures to sell at the Christmas fair.

In maths we have begun to look at multiplication and the ways we can use our knowledge of times tables to help us figure out bigger calculations such as 22 multiplied by 4. To do this we partition the numbers into a grid and we have also started to look at using the column method. At the end of this week, we moved on to looking at division and sharing numbers within our times tables into groups.

In English, the children have been working on speech marks and looking at how to use them in direct speech for example: "stop that please!" exclaimed Joe. We have also been looking at the possessive apostrophe and how it changes how many people or things own or control something. For example: The dragon's flight = 1 dragon and The dragons' flight = more than 1. We have gone on to write our own chapters for George's Marvellous medicine, where the children have created their own medicines and the effect that it has on Grandma. They have been very adventurous


