The children have looked at adding and subtracting using numberlines and we have now progressed onto the formal written method of column addition. The children are certainly getting to grips with the basics of this though we will still need to work on `carrying over' from the ones column to the tens column.

With our project, we are starting to research people we consider to be heroes. The children have a real range of ideas from vets, doctors and nurses to Christiano Ronaldo! This will help them to write a biography/information text on their heroes.

During Jigsaw this week, we have continued to look at celebrating differences. The children have been sharing worries and they have sought the advice of their peers.
